THE GREAT FEAST OF THE TRANSFIGURATION OF CHRIST

عيد عظيم لتجلي ربنا يسوع المسيح

Our Lord had taught His disciples and spoken to them of His death and resurrection. He had promised, “there are some standing here who shall not taste of death, till they see the Son of Man coming in His Kingdom” (Matt. 16.28). He fulfilled this promise when He took Peter, James and John up Mt. Tabor and was transfigured before them.

Order for Holy Communion

Members of the Orthodox Church age seven and above must prepare for Holy Communion with a recent confession, prayer, fasting from all food and drink from midnight (unless a medical condition preclude it), being in church *before* the Epistle and Gospel readings, and being at peace with everyone.

As there are **NO CHURCH SCHOOL** classes today, children should sit with their parents and come to Communion with them. An usher will dismiss your row from the center aisle. Then return to your place by a side aisle for the prayers of thanksgiving and the final blessing and dismissal. Please let choir members pass when they come down for Communion.

A Warm Welcome to Our Guests

We are glad you are worshipping with us. Please note that participation in **Holy Communion is limited to members of the Orthodox Church** in good standing, who have prepared with prayer, fasting and a recent confession.

For all others: though we cannot share Communion with you—since it is an expression of membership and full unity in faith—you are welcome to come forward after the dismissal, receive a blessing and partake of the blessed bread (from the large bowls). Please also sign our guest book and introduce yourself to Fr. Nabil or Fr. Andrew during coffee hour. You may inquire with them how you can become a member.

THE SCRIPTURE LESSONS

Prokeimenon (Psalm 103.24, 1 LXX; Tone 4)

O Lord, how marvelous are Thy works. In wisdom hast Thou made them all.

Verse: Bless the Lord, O my soul. O Lord, my God, Thou art very great.

From St. Peter's Second General Epistle (1.10-19; Transfiguration)

BRETHREN, be the more zealous to confirm your call and election, for if you do this you will never fall; so there will be richly provided for you an entrance into the eternal Kingdom of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

Therefore, I intend always to remind you of these things, though you know them and are established in the truth that you have. I think it right, as long as I am in this body, to arouse you by way of reminder, since I know that the putting off of my body will be soon, as our Lord Jesus Christ showed me. And I will see to it that after my departure you may be able at any time to recall these things.

For we did not follow cleverly devised myths when we made known to you the power and coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, but we were eyewitnesses of his majesty. For when He received honor and glory from God the Father and the voice was borne to Him by the Majestic Glory, "This is my beloved Son, with Whom I am well pleased," we heard this voice borne from heaven, for we were with Him on the holy mountain. And we have the prophetic word made more sure. You will do well to pay attention to this as to a lamp shining in a dark place, until the day dawns and the morning star rises in your hearts.

لأننا لم نتبع حرافات مُصنعة، إذ أعلنناكم قوة ربنا يسوع المسيح وبهيته، بل كنا معاينين جلاله، لأنه أخذ من الله الأب الكرامة والمجد، إذ جاءه من المجد الفخيم صوت يقول: "هذا هو ابني الحبيب الذي به سررت"، وقد سمعنا نحن هذا الصوت آتيا من السماء حين كنا معه في الجبل المقدس. وعندنا أثبت من ذلك، وهو كلام الأنبياء، الذي تحسنون إذا أصغيتهم إليه، كأنه مصباح يضيء في مكان مظلم، إلى أن ينفجر النهار، ويشرق كوكب الصبح في قلوبكم.

Holy Gospel according to St. Matthew (17.1-9; Transfiguration)

AT THAT TIME, Jesus took with him Peter and James and John his brother, and led them up a high mountain apart. And He was transfigured before them, and His face shown like the sun, and His garments became white as light. And behold, there appeared to them Moses and Elijah, talking with Him. And Peter said to Jesus, "Lord, it is well that we are here; if you wish, I will make three booths here, one for you and one for Moses and one for Elijah." He was still speaking, when lo, a bright cloud overshadowed them, and a voice from the cloud said, "This is my beloved Son, with Whom I am well pleased; listen to Him!" When the disciples heard this, they fell on their faces and were filled with awe. But Jesus came and touched them, saying, "Rise, and have no fear." And when they lifted up their eyes, they saw no one but Jesus only.

And as they were coming down the mountain, Jesus commanded them, "Tell no one the vision, until the Son of Man is raised from the dead."

BLESSING OF GRAPES AND FIRST-FRUITS

Please place the fruit you brought on the table for blessing, under the icon of Christ on the Iconostasis.

After "Blessed be the Name of the Lord", the clergy gather in the center of the church, in front of the table where the grapes/fruits are placed for blessing.

The choir chants the festal apolytikion and kontakion. Then the deacon lifts his orarion and says:



Deacon: Let us pray to the Lord.

Choir: Lord, have mercy.

Priest: Bless, O Lord, this new fruit of the vine, which thou hast graciously been pleased to permit to come to maturity, through calm seasons and gentle rains and favorable weather; and let it be unto joy for those of us who shall partake of this offspring of the vine; and may we offer it as a gift to thee unto the purification of our sins, through the sacred and holy Body and Blood of thy Christ, with whom thou art blessed together with thine all-holy and good and life-giving Spirit, now and ever, and unto ages of ages.

Choir: Amen.

The priest sprinkles the grapes with holy water, saying thrice:

Priest: These grapes are blessed through sprinkling with this holy water, in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.

The choir responds each time:

Choir: Amen.

We will also anoint everyone present with myrrh from the tomb of the Theotokos.

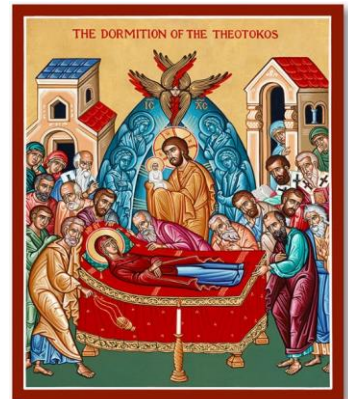
AUGUST 14: FEAST OF THE DORMITION POTLUCK
